閱讀教學流程: (可用文字敘述, 或照片說故事) 一、教學目標: 以 "How Do Dinosaurs Eat Their Food?" 這本英語繪本為教材。首先, 利用有趣的繪本故事名稱標題, 引發學生的好奇與興趣。接著, 運用故事中淺顯易懂的圖文, 讓學生在重覆出現的句型, 與簡單清楚的故事結構中, 學習到句型與新的字彙, 並建立簡單的文法概念, 培養出基本的英語閱讀能力。並經由故事可學習到用餐時的禮儀和常規。 二、學習內容: 1. Vocabulary: 能認讀即可, 不要求拼字及背誦。 fuss, fidget, squirm, flip, drop, chew, bubble, stick up, glare, spit out, squeeze, polite, eat up, burp, belch, noise, rude cereal, spaghetti, broccoli, milk, bean, orange 2. Sentence Pattern: How does a dinosaur eat all his food? Does he pick at.....? Yes/No.... He eats..... 三、教學活動與學習單: 1. 教學步驟: (1) Show the cover page	

展示故事繪本的封面，並念出故事書的名稱，請學生說出關於故事內容可能發展的初步印象和看法。

(2) Answer questions



請小朋友回答與封面有關的問題：

A. Do you like dinosaurs? Why or Why not?

B. What kind of food do you think that dinosaurs would like to eat?

(把學生說出的食物名稱列於黑板上)

C. What will happen in this story? (預測繪本的內容)

(3) Listen to the CD

播放 CD，第一次先不看書，讓學生們猜猜看書裡講什麼？第二次讓學生們邊聽邊看書，藉此他們可以初步了解故事的內容。把書中提到的生字列出，並加以分類，例如：食物的名稱，各種表示



(4) Introduction of sentence patterns and new vocabulary

A. 字彙：

食物：cereal, spaghetti, broccoli, milk, bean

不合宜的行為動作：fuss, fidget, squirm, flip, drop, chew, bubble, stick up, glare, spit out, squeeze, rude, noise

合宜的行為動作：polite, eat up, sit still, goodwill

B. 句型：

How does a dinosaur eat his food?

Does he pick at...? Yes/No....

He eats....

(5) Introduce the story

A. 帶讀單字，並運用字典查出單字的意思。

B. 把單字帶入句型，並且講解整個故事內容，讓學生了解整個故事的意思。

C. 學習重點：

對於食物的認知（營養的食物不一定好吃）

合宜的用餐禮儀



(6) Read the story

A. 首先由老師帶讀，學生們跟讀故事內容。

B. 加強單字的熟練度，以及句型的流利程度。

C. 分組練習，由程度較佳的學生提醒程度較弱的學生練習。

D. 老師在朗讀故事的過程中，須注意配合動作、表情、語調，也提醒學

生在練習的過程中不可忽略。

(7) **Reader's theater** (繪本的表演)

讓學生分組表演，經由聲音、動作、模擬，把故事繪本每一頁的場景，以較為生動的方式呈現出來。藉由這個練習及表演，可以加深對句型的了解及運用。



(8) **Draw a picture**

請學生畫出一隻最喜歡的恐龍，並用所學到的單字、句型在圖畫上寫出一個句子。
